## HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE?

Due to the cancellation of large public gatherings, we have designed a field guide for families to have **"church at home"**. We have also designed a companion Bible Reading Field Guide to provide your children with a reading plan and activities to help them engage with God's word throughout the week. Use this Family Worship Field Guide for a special weekly devotional time. Download from our website at [central365.org](http://central365.org) or the Central Kids facebook page.

## GATHER

Gather your family together in the living room and inform kids that you're going to have church at home today. Stay positive and don't get discouraged if they moan and groan at first. Try to pick a time like Sunday morning when it is already a routine.

## SING

Play song or watch worship video, "Do Not Be Anxious (Philippians 4:6-7)" by Seeds Family Worship on YouTube.

## WATCH

Watch Video "Gospels of Luke Ch. 9-19" by The Bible Project on Tablet, Phone or TV. Find Bible Project Videos on Youtube or [BibleProject.com](http://BibleProject.com)

## DISCUSS

If your children finished the BIBLE READING FIELD GUIDE, discuss some of the stories they read from Luke 9-19 and talk about any questions they may have. Discuss what you heard and saw in the Luke 9-19 Bible Project video. What stood out?

## READ - Luke 12:22-32 (CSB)

Select someone in your family to read the following Scripture aloud. You could also take turns reading through the passage together. Kids love to participate!

### The Cure for Anxiety

22 Then he said to the disciples: "Therefore I tell you, don't worry about your life, what you will eat; or about the body, what you will wear. 23 For life is more than food and the body more than clothing. 24 Consider the ravens: They don't sow or reap; they don't have a storeroom or a barn; yet God feeds them. Aren't you worth more than the birds? 25 Can any of you add one moment to his life-span by worrying? If then you're not able to do even a little thing, why worry about the rest? 27 Consider how the wildflowers grow: They don't labor or spin thread. Yet I tell you, not even Solomon in all his splendor was adorned like one of these. 28 If

that's how God clothes the grass, which is in the field today and thrown into the furnace tomorrow, how much more will he do for you - you of little faith? Don't strive for what you should eat and what you should drink, and don't be anxious. 30 For the Gentile world eagerly seeks all these things, and your father knows that you need them. 31 But seek his kingdom, and these things will be provided for you. 32 Don't be afraid, little flock, because your father delights to give you the kingdom.

## MEDITATE

Talk with your kids about how they may be feeling right now with what's happening world wide. What can we do if we are feeling scared or worried? What does it mean to seek God's kingdom? What things will God provide?

## MEMORIZE

Have kids memorize the verses below. Play the song "Do Not Be Anxious" several times this week so God's Word is always on your minds.

**"Don't not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV)**

## PRAY

Pray for peace from God, peace that only he can give. Pray for people who may be sick or scared. Pray for your neighbours or loved ones who don't know Jesus, that they may turn to him for hope and salvation.

Hey Kids,

I want to remind you that we serve a HUGE God! Even though things may seem different right now, God is always in control because God is **sovereign**. Jesus, fully God and fully man, died on the cross to save us. He did this all because he loves us. John 3:16 says that God loved the world so much that he gave his only son, and whoever believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. We can put our hope and trust in Jesus, and one day we will live forever with him where all things will be made new.
