- 3. What comfort do we find in the fact that Jesus claims that he accomplished the goal he set out to accomplish?
- 4. If God's Glory is defined as "The public display of the infinite beauty and worth of God", then how does the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus glorify God? What things are revealed in this particular and integral revelation?
- 5. How might we, as recipients of God's grace, become conduits of displaying His worth and beauty to the world around us? What tangible and proximal (close at hand) things can we do to glorify God?
- 6. Jesus acts as our eternal intercessor (Hebrews 7:25). This "High Priestly Prayer" is a taste of His never ceasing prayers for us as believers. How might the first 5 verses build a foundation of confidence in the prayer Jesus continues to utter throughout the rest of John 17?
