STARTING THE DISCUSSION...

Canadians are among the wealthiest people in the world. While we don't always feel particularly wealthy, based on the amount of money that the average Canadian makes and the quality of life we enjoy, we are far above most other people on earth. The question we ought to ask then is what do we do with our wealth? The easy answer that we can fall into is simply to use our money to buy more things. Whether we are trying to fill our houses with more stuff or using shopping as a way of dealing with stress, the default answer in our culture is to use our money to buy more stuff. Yet the gospel compels us to a different answer! We follow a saviour who became poor that we might be rich. Who gave up everything and became a servant that we might know him. That example motivates how we use our wealth, not for ourselves but for the good of others. Our money then becomes another way of revealing the true worth of knowing Jesus as we generously give our material blessings for the good of others and the glory of God.

KEY TEXT: PSALM 67

- 4. In light of what the gospel calls us to do, how do you sense the Holy Spirit calling you to respond when it comes to your time, talents and possessions?

PRAYING & ACTING

- 1. How can our group show the gospel in our community when it comes to materialism? What practical steps could we take to help our neighbourhood hear the gospel?
- 2. Pray that God would use our words and our actions to show the superior greatness of Jesus through our lives.
